Friends in Christ,

Plenty of others participated in other ways; our readers, communion assistants, acolytes, ushers, greeters, choirs, ensembles, and others who helped to make our worship services run; thank you. Whether you were a volunteer who signed up weeks ahead of time or got recruited on the spot; thank you.

Whether you know this or not, we have lost a number of our regular volunteers for certain roles over the course of COVID. Several of them have gone on to the church triumphant, and some are not physically able to continue volunteering in the same way they used to. What that means is that we have a need for new volunteers to take on roles in worship, and to serve God and their church as acolytes, readers, ushers, communion assistants, and more. Most of these roles are not hard at all, and most of them can even be done while you still get to sit with your family for the worship service.

During COVID we have tried to make the signups more convenient. We have moved them all to our website. So, my invitation and even request is to prayerfully consider what you might be able to sign up for to assist in our praise of God during worship. Or, come talk to me if you have questions or would like training before you sign up, and I will connect you with the right people.

Worship is such an essential part of our faith and our life together. Take part in leading the way.

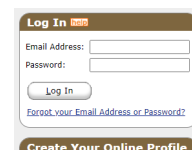

Search for replacement for Director of Faith Formation

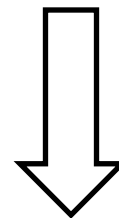
- A 6 person call committee will be formed representing a relevant group of individuals. Pastor Aaron to reach out to suggested candidates and will confirm final committee.

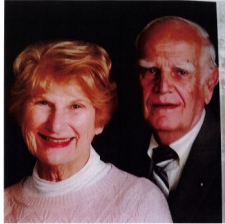

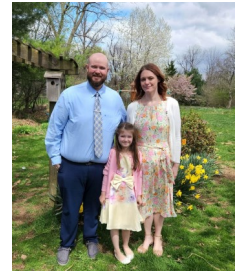

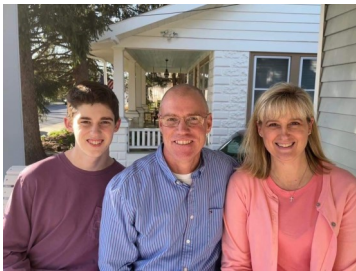

We will be working on our individual projects and on making plarn, which is used to make sleeping mats for the homeless.

If you are interested in helping our ministry by donating yarn, we encourage you to buy 3 or 4 skeins of one color. We use Homespun, Red Heart or any 4 ply yarn. We seem to be short on masculine colors so - grays, browns, dark blues, dark greens and cream colored would be great. If you would like to add 2 skeins of variegated yarn to match the color and type of yarn you pick, we could use that as well. Drop by on the 8th, give it to a committee member or place the yarn on the counter in the Outreach Center and mark it for Shawl Ministry.

For those of you who place individuals on our prayer chains - if you would like that person to receive a prayer shawl or a prayer blanket, please call the church office or one of our chairmen - Lynne Neibert, Sandy Breech or Maggie Strawser with the necessary information.

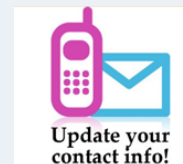
