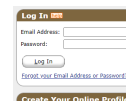

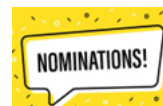

BLESSING OF THE ANIMALS SERVICE— FOR OUR ANIMAL FRIENDS THAT ARE FAMILY.

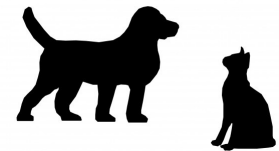

SAFETY & SECURITY

Hello Church Family,

I hope this October Newsletter finds everyone doing well. It's still warm as I write this, but soon leaves will be changing and falling, some people will be drinking their Pumpkin Spice Mocha Latte Iced Cappuccino, (sorry, I drink strong dark black coffee), plus days and nights should be getting cooler. Remember when driving those leaf piles along the road may contain more than leaves. Kids love playing in leaf piles so as you drive by be vigilant, watch for children playing in the leaves. Be careful because when it rains the leaves on the road can cause slippery conditions, causing almost icy type conditions, affecting your vehicle's braking, accelerating and steering. Let's be careful. I don't want to meet you by accident, meaning your accident. EMS humor, it doesn't always translate well to those not in Emergency Services.

Throughout the past several months, the Safety and Security Team along with Property Committee have been busy. The exterior locks have been re-keyed, due to the large number of keys distributed that were unaccounted for. The Kitchen and Choir Room exterior doors have been added to the Brivo Access System. There have been additional outside lights added to dark areas around the Kitchen/Choir entrance.

On the exterior of the building, you will see numbers over the entrances. These are to help direct First Responders to the closest entrance in the event there is an emergency.

You will notice signs indicating East and West Wings on exterior building walls, as well as signs indicating the Office location. Some of the Entrances that were on the access system have been upgraded that both doors now unlock using the Brivo Cards or App, so there is no need to use the hex keys to dog down the push bars. The mounting of auxiliary locks for the Youth Education Wing has been completed as well.

If anyone is in need of church building access, please contact Chuck Sterling or me, Dennis Stoner, to be issued your Brivo Credentials, either proximity card or cell phone app.

If you have any additional questions regarding any other safety or security issue(s), please feel free to call or email me.
